As well as being a member of National Bank's strategic art acquisition committee, he has also sat on the board of directors of the *Fondation du Musée d'art contemporain de Montréal* since 2010. He is also a member of the advisory board for the *Accélérateur Banque Nationale — HEC Montréal*, whose mission is to develop innovative entrepreneurs. He stands out for his engaging leadership in both his professional activities and his personal commitments, and is known for his ability to create high-performing teams made up of exceptional, determined people.
