Since 2014, Raymond Bachand has been a Strategic Advisor to law firm Norton Rose Fulbright Canada LLP and President of the Institut du Québec, a research centre created by The Conference Board of Canada and HEC Montréal. He has been a member of the board of directors of Transat A.T. Inc. since 2014 and was appointed Lead Director in September 2018. He served as Chairman of the board of directors of Tourisme Montréal from 2014 to 2018. Raymond Bachand was the Member of the Assemblée nationale du Québec for the Outremont riding from 2005 to 2013. During this period, he held a number of different positions and ran several government departments, including Economic Development, Innovation and Export Trade, Tourism, Finance and Revenue. He was also the Minister responsible for the Montreal region and the Official Opposition Critic for finance. Throughout his career, Raymond Bachand has held several senior positions in the private sector, particularly the positions of Vice-President, Planning and Development at Metro Richelieu Inc., President and Chief Executive Officer of Fonds de solidarité des travailleurs du Québec (F.T.Q.) and President and Chief Executive Officer of Secor Consulting Inc. He has a Licence of Law from Université de Montréal as well as an MBA and a Doctorate in Administration from the Harvard University Graduate School of Business Administration.
